- **Advancing Campus Development**: Preparing for long-term mission and vision, both spiritually and physically, to reach future generations.

FASTING: ENCOURAGEMENT

As we begin this 21-day journey of prayer, we want to encourage you to consider the spiritual discipline of fasting. Throughout Scripture, fasting is a powerful way to draw near to God, align our hearts with His purposes, and seek His guidance with clarity and humility. It is a tangible expression of our dependence on Him and a way to heighten our awareness of His presence.

Fasting is more than simply abstaining from food—it is an intentional time to fix our eyes on God. By setting aside physical nourishment or distractions, we create space to deepen our relationship with Him. It is a time to seek His will for our lives and our church and to pray for His transforming power to work in us and through us.

During this 21-day prayer focus, fasting can serve as a reminder of our commitment to God's vision for The Glade Church. Whether fasting from food, specific types of food, or distractions such as media, the goal is to create room for God to move in a deeper way.

The length and type of your fast can be tailored to your personal circumstances:

- Some may fast a single meal, a day each week, or abstain from certain foods or drinks for the full 21 days.
- Others may choose non-food fasts, such as giving up social media or other activities that compete for their attention.

Consistency—such as fasting on the same day each week—can help create a rhythm and unite us as a church body in this discipline. The key is to approach your fast with humility and prayer, trusting that God will honor your desire to seek Him.

FASTING: WORD OF CAUTION

If you have medical conditions or dietary restrictions, please consult your doctor before beginning a fast. Fasting should never harm your body. If a traditional fast is not possible, consider other ways to abstain and focus your heart, such as fasting from entertainment, screens, or non-essential activities.

Fasting has deep roots in Scripture. Consider reading the following passages to learn more:

- Jesus fasted for 40 days before beginning His ministry (Matthew 4:1-11).
- Daniel fasted for understanding and God's guidance (Daniel 10:2-3).
- The early church fasted when seeking direction and commissioning leaders (Acts 13:2-3).

Fasting is not about earning God's favor but about creating space for God to work in our hearts and align us with His will.

As we fast during these 21 days, we are seeking:

- Clarity for God's vision for The Glade Church through 2030.
- Unity as we amplify gospel impact, multiply disciples, and embrace servant leadership.
- Dependence on God to guide and provide for every step of the mission.

Whether your fast is short or long, simple or sacrificial, the most important thing is to approach this time with expectation and humility. Let your hunger remind you of your deeper hunger for God's presence. Let your prayers reflect a longing to see His kingdom come and His will be done in Wilson County and beyond.

As we journey through this season of prayer and fasting, let us encourage one another to remain steadfast. Together, we are laying the foundation for what God wants to accomplish through The Glade Church. Let us trust Him to lead us, provide for us, and transform us for His glory.

Will you pray for all that God will do in and through us during this season? May this time of prayer and fasting draw us closer to Him and prepare us for the mission ahead.
